Interrail Specifics

- Bike chain (helps to keep backpacks together when put onto buses, trains, coaches etc. You can also use it to attach your bag around table legs on trains so you can sleep and not worry about your bag being stolen)
- Laundry powder / pods

- Poncho (big enough to cover backpack too)
- Phone Lanyard
- Crease release (£2 home bargains & is a 10/10 purchase)
- Packing Cubes
- Mini backpack to attach to big one (use carabiner)
- USB charging station
- Train passes & seat reservations
